The 11/2d had 7,800 exchanged, the 4d 9,000 exchanged and the 6d and 1/- 13,000 exchanged.

Requisition Number 1058.1 - 1951

It would seem that the Bureau were trying to control the distribution of these stamps because, as with the previous requisitions, many of the printed stamps were to be exchanged. The 1d had 6,500 exchanged, the 2d 28,700, 3d 10,260, 6d 15,360, 1/- 13,270, 2/6d 6,700, 5/- 4,200 and finally the 10/- with 6,800 exchanged.

This requisition also had a number of stamps sent to the Bureau which is noted under the Specimen heading.
